



## 2018 Grüner Veltliner

**Tasting Notes:** Fleshy texture with flavors of ripe peach and nectarine, drizzled with a touch of honey. Aged for six months in Oregon Oak barrels to add depth and richness.

**Appellation:** Willamette Valley

**Vineyard:** 50% Estate Vineyard & 50% Wolf Hill Vineyard

**Suggested Food Pairings:** Mushroom risotto or roasted turkey

**Winemaker Notes:** In the words of Kanye West, “Everything I’m not makes me everything I am.” Our Willamette Valley Pinot Gris is a blend of fruit from the East Valley, the South Salem Hills and Eola-Amity Hills. The idea is to blend fruit from different soil types and microclimates to create a true representation of Willamette Valley Pinot Gris. We age the wine for six months in 10% new Oregon Oak barrels to give it richer texture and a deeper sense of *terrior*.
