



## 2018 Pinot Noir

Winemaker Notes: The best thing about our Hare Vineyard is also our biggest challenge. It consistently produces low alcohol, high acid wines that are food friendly and age worthy. In 2018, we blended our pinot noir with fruit from a riper vineyard, to create a wine that is more balanced. It is still low alcohol, fresh and vibrant; but the blended fruit rounds out the texture to make it more user friendly.

**Appellation**: Willamette Valley

Vineyard: 80% Hare Vineyard & 20% Kecia's Vineyard
