



2017 Pinot Noir Hare Vineyard

Tasting Notes: A delicate and restrained pinot noir with excellent long-term aging potential. Our high elevation vineyard creates bright, fresh wines with red fruit and earthy undertones.

Suggested Food Pairings: Roasted Chicken or Butternut Squash

Appellation: Willamette Valley

Vineyard:

100% Hare Vineyard, 800 ft elevation, LIVE farming certification (pending 2019) South Salem Hills, Red Clay Jory soils, average vine age ~ 25 years.

Cases Produced: 100

Technical Data:

pH - 3.4 TA – 7.1 ABV – 13.4%

Winemaking Notes: Fermented with a combination of vineyard yeast and yeast passed down from our winemaking mentors. 21-day on skins, 30% whole cluster. Barrel aged in 50% new French Oak for 10 months. The high elevation and shallow soils of the Hare Vineyard create a wine with bright fruit, low alcohol and high acidity. The new French Oak creates structure and balance, resulting in a wine that may be austere in its youth, but should age with style and grace.
