



2019 Rosé

Tasting Notes: Reminiscent of the dried strawberries they would send into outer space with the astronauts, this wine is bursting with red fruit flavors that make it easy to drink and easy to love.

Suggested Food Pairings: Grilled salmon and garlic spears

Appellation: Willamette Valley

Vineyard:

75% Hare Vineyard 800 ft elevation, red clay Jory soils, located in the hills of South Salem, average vine age $^{\sim}$ 25 years

25% Scenic Valley Vineyard

Marine Sedimentary soils, average vine age ~ 10 years

Technical Data:

pH - 3.33 RS - 4.8 g/L ABV - 12.9%

Winemaking Notes: We start with carbonic maceration of pinot noir, to extract bright red fruit flavors from the pinot noir and kick off a wild fermentation. After that we use a combination of whole cluster press and overnight cold soak to give the wine more complexity and depth. We add small amounts of pinot gris and chardonnay to give the wine texture, small amounts of gamay and tempranillo to give the wine extra fruit, and red pinot noir to give the wine more color and depth. It's a long complex process to make a wine that is simple fruity, and fun.
